## A message from the Chair

Dear Choir members and friends,

I hope you have all had a wonderful summer. We are now gearing up for a very welcome return to rehearsals in the Memorial Hall and are looking forward to getting together and singing again. Our first rehearsal will begin on Wednesday, 15th September at 7:30pm. We anticipate a full term of rehearsing with a break for half term on Wednesday 27th October and then continuing until Wednesday, 15th December. Being mindful of members' safety at all times, unfortunately, we will not be undertaking our usual Christmas concert in the Memorial Hall this year. However, I am delighted to say that we have been invited to lead a 'singalong' at the Ty Mawr on Wednesday, December 15th, so Christmas is not completely cancelled! More details to follow.

We met as a committee yesterday and decided upon the following mitigations for your safety and attention:

- If you feel unwell, please do not attend rehearsals
- If you have Covid symptoms, have tested positive (PCR or lateral flow), have been told to self-isolate, have been in close contact with anyone who has tested positive or are quarantining after a visit abroad, please do not attend rehearsals
- Continue to email Martin Bye to advise attendance at rehearsals (by 5pm the Tuesday before please)

including chairs, prior to rehearsals that are likely to be touched by members

- Tom will continue to email which music to bring to rehearsals. Please download/print as appropriate. Where possible, we will provide music to those who do not have any
- Rehearsals will take place between 7:30pm and 9:00pm with a 10 minute break
- A revised risk assessment has been carried out in line with both the current WG regulations and information from LMH. This is available on our website.

We know that no vaccination is 100% effective and so we are relying very much on everyone's adherence to current legislation and for everyone to follow any additional safety measures that are put in place by the committee.

A huge thank you to you all for continuing to support our choir through the current pandemic. Looking forward to seeing you all again on September 15th.
