## A message from the Chair

Dear Choir members and friends,

We resume after our Easter break this Wednesday, April 21st. For this half term, there will be four weeks of rehearsals via Zoom followed by a social event on May 19th.

Thank you very much to those who completed the online survey about returning to rehearsals in person. The committee have outlined plans for how we envisage our rehearsals will look. We are delighted to propose that:

- In-person rehearsals will start on **Wednesday, June 9<sup>th</sup>**.
- Rehearsals will take place outside the Memorial Hall in the car park: on Zoom if it is raining.
- A full risk assessment is currently being carried out which includes at least 2m social distancing between everyone; correct and appropriate PPE to be worn at all times by all participants; no cars in the car park; appropriate breaks during rehearsals.
- Sanitised chairs will be provided, but if you prefer to bring your own chair, please do.
- There will be no sharing of music.
- There may be a restriction of 30 members at in-person rehearsals outdoors.

However, these proposals are still very tentative at this stage and could change due to further restrictions being put into place by Welsh Government. Please note that as no vaccination is 100% effective, we are all relying very much on members' adherence to current legislation and to follow any additional safety measures that are put in place by the committee. We will, of course, keep you fully updated and informed about these proposed arrangements.

A huge thank you to you all for continuing to support our choir through the current pandemic.
