Happy New Year!

Dear Choir members and friends,

I hope you have all had a wonderful Christmas and new year. Rehearsals will begin on Wednesday, 12th January at 7:30pm. Fingers crossed for a full term of rehearsing!

Thank you again to those who attended our pre-Christmas events. I'm sure you'll agree that we thoroughly enjoyed ourselves and can't wait for next Christmas to do it all over again! I am delighted to say that, following on from the very successful 'Singalong' at Thornhill Church Centre, we have been asked to perform there again towards the end of term although we don't have dates as yet. More details to follow.

Our Risk Assessment has been updated to take account of new rules, regulations and recommendations from the Welsh Government. This will be uploaded to our website shortly. Please note the following mitigations for your safety and attention:

- If you feel unwell, please do not attend rehearsals
- If you have Covid symptoms, have tested positive (PCR or lateral flow), have been told to self-isolate, have been in close contact with anyone who has tested positive or are quarantining after a visit abroad, please do not attend rehearsals
- In line with the latest Welsh Government advice, we encourage you to take a lateral flow test prior to attending rehearsals. These can be obtained from pharmacies or from <https://www.gov.uk/>

- Face coverings must be worn at all times in LMH; please bring an extra one to change during the break
- LMH fresh air ventilation system will be used throughout the rehearsal; outside doors will be left open
- LMH is deep cleaned on a daily basis and the committee will additionally disinfect all surfaces prior to rehearsals that are likely to be touched by members
- Please ensure you bring all of this term's music to all rehearsals
- Rehearsals will take place between 7:30pm and 9:00pm with a 10 minute break

We know that no vaccination is 100% effective and so we are relying very much on everyone's adherence to current legislation, for members to be triple vaccinated and for everyone to follow any additional safety measures that are put in place by the committee. So far, thanks to everyone sticking to our rules, there have been no cases of Covid arising either as a result of rehearsals or any of our Christmas events which is great news.

So a huge THANKS to you all for continuing to support our choir through the current pandemic. Looking forward to seeing you all again on January 12th.
